## Major Accident Prevention Policy

- Comply with applicable legal requirements and rules defined in our Integrated Management System (IMS) that involves dangerous substances prevention.
- Identify major potential accidents and dangerous substances, appropriately monitor their risks and manage changes diligently through the Management of Change Process.

**Neste Singapore recognizes** the nature of our business activities may give rise to major accident hazards that may impact our employees, neighbours, contractors, visitors, members of the public and the natural and build environment, We are therefore obligated to all these stakeholders to reduce the risks associated with these hazards and undertake the following commitments:

- Provide all necessary resources as needed and in proportion to the identified hazards, to prevent major accidents.
- Implement management, operation and maintenance procedures to ensure the safe functioning of facilities and refinery processes to prevent major accident involving dangerous substances.
- Ensure that the Emergency Response Plan is operationally ready and coordinated with External Emergency Responders to mitigate major accidents and release of dangerous substances.
- Periodically review the policies of IMS and MAPP, taking into consideration feedback from stakeholders, to ensure that both policies remain relevant and effective.
- Set, monitor and implement performance goals to prevent major accidents.
